Description

Sturdy body transporter with fixed height, integrated water cooler, detachable handle, 4 large 150mm dia. wheels for easy maneuvering, body tray with 8 small wheels and cover with thermal insulation. Especially developed for the temporary storage of bodies in a chilled environment at a minimum of 10°C!

Features

- 1 x u-shaped transfer rails for accommodation of one transfer body tray with 8 small wheels and fixation mechanism for tray
- Solid construction with a manual "body tray lifting device" away from cooling platform for loading / unloading
- 4 large wheels (180mm dia.) with bearing will assure best and easy operation / maneuverability. All 4 wheels have a foot operated locking system. One wheel may be supplied with a "straight drive mechanism" for better track holding (option). Wheels in trackless construction for use in hospitals (no black rubber trails)
- detachable push handle fastened at lower frame (950mm high). plastic ram protectors at front
- cover for body tray with 4 handles and 2 quick release locks at each side in order to assure a good seal to the main frame
- body tray with 8 small wheels and 2 closeable drain holes
- integrated cold water unit mounted to frame of transporter
- cooling platform 2000(L) x 550(W) x 30(H)mm with bleed valve connected to cold water unit for accommodation of one body tray with the cadaver
